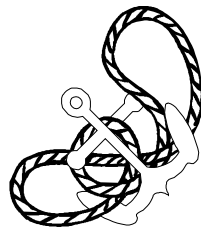
I noticed that we have not collected very much for the Food Bank. If anyone wants to make a donation, please do so by our next meeting. I will deliver what we have after the meeting.

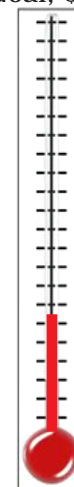
