Quick recipe for Irish Stewed

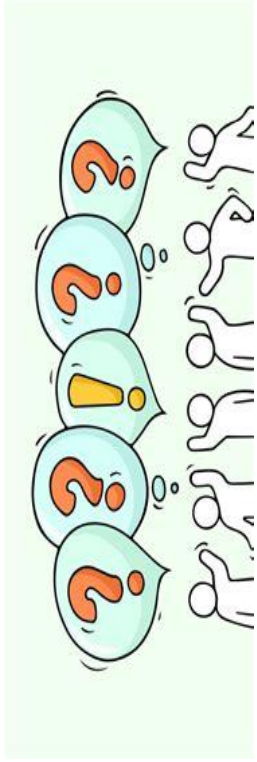
Makes one serving:

Question and Answer with Port Commissioners



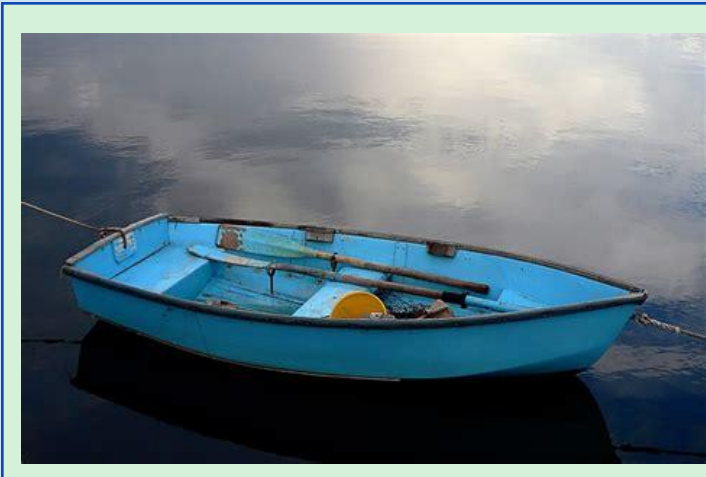
